

Supplemental Brackets and Spacer

Tools Required

Drill-drive, ¼" Socket for self-tapping screws provided, 4" Extension

Installation

These instructions apply to installation of:

Supplemental Brackets for the panel connections shown;

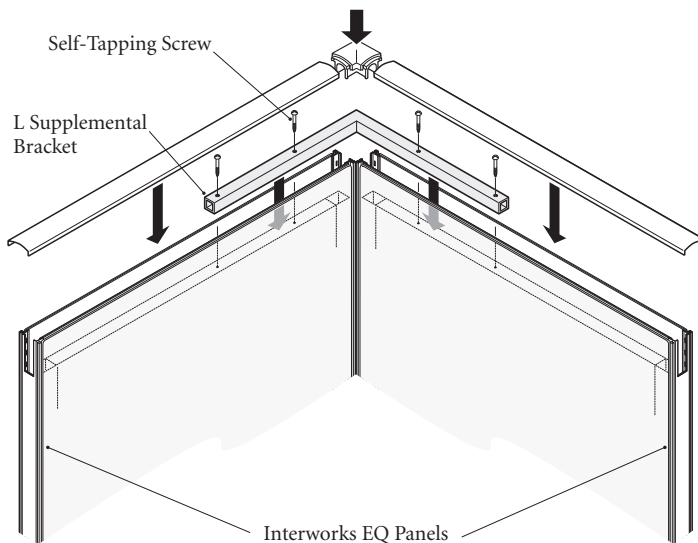
Supplemental Bracket Spacer to compensate for depth difference between cable channels of a 10P Tackable Acoustical panel and 11P Models.

Supplemental Bracket

- Remove panel top cap, lift and rotate away from panel
- Place supplemental bracket down into cable channel
- Align panels
- Use provided self-tapping screws to attach – 2 screws per each panel

Finishing

- Replace panel top caps

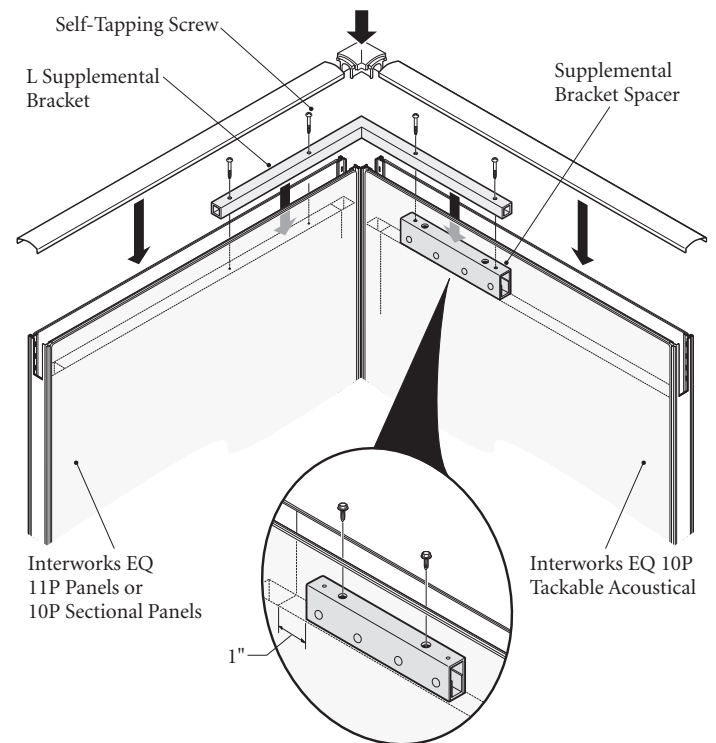


Supplemental Bracket and Spacer (For Difference in Cable Channel Depth)

- Remove panel top cap, lift and rotate away from panel
- Place supplemental bracket spacer into deeper cable channel
- Place 1" from vertical wall, attach with supplied screws
- Position supplemental bracket into cable channel
- Align spacer bracket screw holes with supplemental bracket holes
- Align panels
- Use provided self-tapping screws to attach supplemental bracket to bracket spacer and panel – 2 screws per each panel

Finishing

- Replace panel top caps



Supplemental Brackets and Spacer (continued)

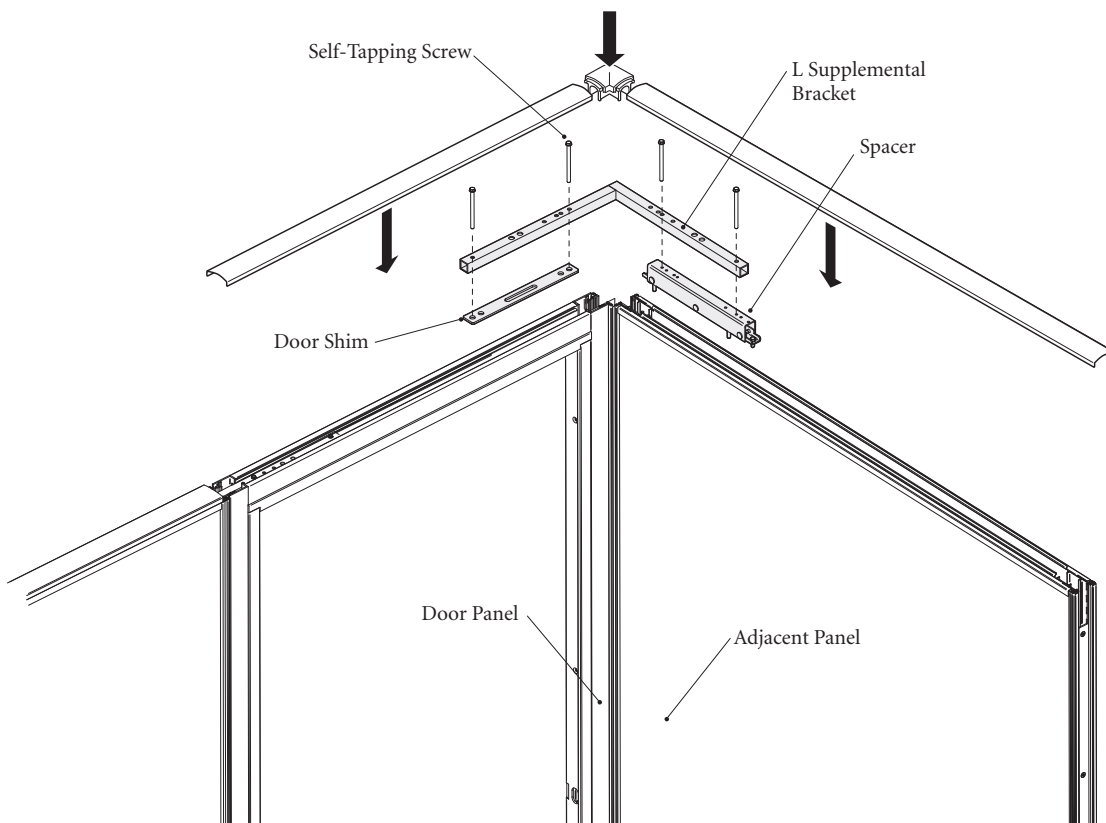
Supplemental Bracket and Spacer

(For Hinged Door Installation)

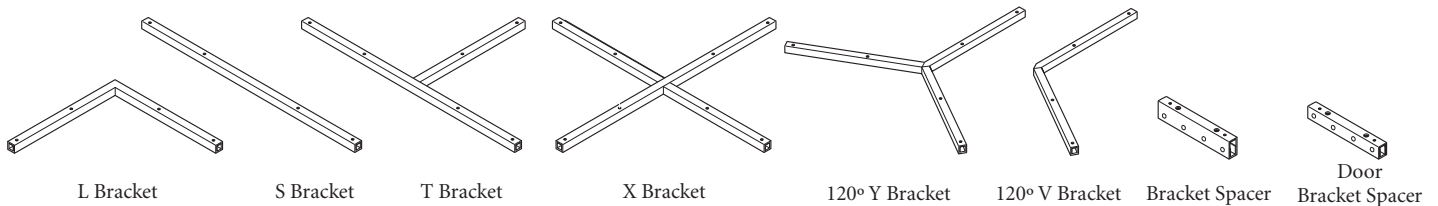
- Remove top caps from door and adjacent panels.
- Place a door shim in the top channel on each side of the door panel. Align end of shim with the vertical frame member of the door panel. Door shim is NOT screwed to the door panel top channel.
- Place supplemental bracket spacer in the adjacent panel. Align end of spacer with the vertical frame member of the adjacent panel.
- Use provided self-tapping screws to attach the spacer to top channel.
- Position supplemental bracket into the top channel of each panel, aligning holes in the bracket with the holes in the spacer and door shim.
- Use provided self-tapping screws to attach the bracket to the spacer in the adjacent panel and the top channel of the door panel.

Finishing

- Replace panel top caps
